TENDER NOTICE
FOR THE SUPPLY OF LABORATORY GLASSWARE (Sputum Containers)

Tenders are invited by the Chief Medical Officer, Revised National Tuberculosis Control Programme, Directorate of Health Services, Panaji – Goa under State Health Society, National Health Mission for the Supply of Laboratory Glassware (Sputum Containers). Tenders complete in all respects should reach this office on or before 10/10/2019 upto 12.00 pm at the above mentioned address and will be opened at 3.00 pm thereafter on the same day in the presence of the tenderer or their duly authorized representative as may be present. The tenders received after the stipulated date and time will not be entertained. Tenders should be super scribed as **“Supply of Laboratory glassware (sputum containers)”**.

The prices should include the prices of delivery and installation of the goods/appliances. Prices to be quoted for individual item separately. The total cost should include the taxes, duties, packing and forwarding, labour charges, insurance, delivery, installation and ex-works if any.

The Earnest Money deposit (EMD) equivalent to 2.5% of the total cost of the supply and installation is required to be sent along with the quotation. The deposit should be in the form of the Demand Draft drawn on any Nationalized Bank in Goa issued in favor of the Revised National Tuberculosis Control Programme, payable at Panaji.

Tender which is not accompanied with the specified amount of EMD and not in conformity with the terms and conditions as well as specifications will be summarily rejected.

Valid Income Tax Clearance Certificate and Sales Tax Clearance Certificate should be produced along with the tender.

Canvassing in connection with tender is strictly prohibited and any other quotation submitted by the party who resorts to canvassing will be liable for rejection.

Overwriting and corrections are not accepted in the complete tender. However, if found unavoidable, such overwriting, correction should be properly attested by the Competent Authority.

Tender should mention proper date with proper reference number. If found incorrect will be liable for rejection.

The opening of the tender and recording the quoted rate in the presence of the supplier does not amount to acceptance of the tender. The acceptance or rejection of the tender depending upon their appropriation and will be decided by the Competent Authority only on detailed scrutiny.

The supplier should clearly indicate the expiry date of laboratory glassware. An assurance for providing this should be submitted. The brochures containing details of item including make and standard along with Companies profile and list of the clients to whom such devices are supplied may be enclosed.

The supplier should be authorized dealer with registered office in the State of Goa.

The product should have a shelf life of at least 2 years from the time of receipt of material by the customer. Manufacturer should declare the same in originals on the letterhead. The bidder shall submit the same at the time of bid opening.

The rates quoted should be valid for at least Six months from the date of acceptance of tender. If the item supplied are found to be sub-standard quality and not according to the specifications approved by this office, the same shall be liable to be summarily rejected.

The complete supply is to be done within 7 days from the date of issue of detailed supply order. The quantities mentioned are indicative. The actual requirement may increase or decrease at the time of purchase.

Late delivery charges – For every week of delay in supplying, installation, commissioning the compensation at minimum 0.5 percent of the value of the items remaining to be supplied after due date limited to maximum of 5% of the total cost shall be charged at the discretion of the Competent Authority.

The parts/item under warranty should be replaced within 48 hrs.

The successful tender has to enter into an agreement with the Department within seven days of the supply order.

The Chief Medical Officer TB Control Programme Panaji reserves the right to accept/reject any tender in part or whole without assigning any reasons thereof. His decision on the dispute in any way shall be final.

In the event of an order being placed with against the tender and failure to supply equipments in accordance with the terms and conditions by acceptance of tender or to replace any items rejected by this office or any person on this behalf within such frame as may be stipulated, the Chief Medical Officer TB Control Programme Panaji shall be entitled to purchase the same from elsewhere without notice to the tender on the account, such equipments from any other service and at such price as the Competent Authority shall at the sole discretion think fit and if such shall exceed the rate set responsible to pay the difference between the price at which such items have been purchased by this office and the price calculated at the rate set out in the schedule.

This office reserves the right to accept or reject the tender.
